Terms and conditions:

- The competition is open to all programs and colleges.
- Participants may edit the video to the best of their creativity before submission. The content of the video should adhere to the theme provided.
- Duration of Video should be as per above guidelines. (includes title and Credits)
- The video in such manner that should not any content which showcases hatred towards any religion or community, gender, caste, or political oriented vibe in any form. Also, there shouldn't be use of any abusive or explicit content in the video or any other objectionable matter.
- The video should not contain any offensive content or foul language. Vulgarity will not be tolerated in any content submitted. Such entries shall be disqualified. GMGC committee holds complete authority to disqualify any such kind of video.
- Copyright content if used in the video should have proper permission and rights.
- Languages allowed to use in the videos are English, Hindi or Gujarati.
- The resolution of reel videos should be 1080 pixels X 1920 pixels.
- Videos should not publish any Social media platforms before the event completion otherwise participant disqualified.
- The judges' decision will be final. No correspondence pertaining to the selection process and decision will be entertained.
- Judging will be based on originality, creativity, and relevance to the theme.
